## Dead Sea Scrolls diacritics in SBL Hebrew and Guttman Mantova bold Pim Rietbroek, 15 January 2015

The diacritics used are:

1. Dot above a letter: U+0307 (also known as the masora dot)

2. Circle above a letter: U+030A

3. Inline circle: U+25E6

Sample text from DJD I, 106, fr. 6, l. 2

In SBL Hebrew 10.25pt:

] שיהמה [י]כפר על שגגיסססל [

In Guttman Mantova bold 9.5pt:

] שיהמה [י]כפר על שגג [י]כפר יול

Note that in the bold text all three Dead Sea Scrolls diacritics mentioned above must be set using SBL Hebrew, because they are missing in the Guttman Mantova bold font.

Also, both the dot above and the circle above need to be repositioned above the letters to which they belong using OpenType Diacritic Positioning; both the dot and the circle above need to appear centered above the letter to which they belong.
